### Qn 1:

Answer: B. 2 and 3 only

#### **Explanation:**

- Statement 1 is incorrect: Biostimulants do not directly supply nutrients like traditional fertilizers. Instead, they stimulate the plant's natural processes to improve nutrient uptake and utilization.
- Statement 2 is correct: Common examples of biostimulants include seaweed extracts, humic and fulvic acids, protein hydrolysates, etc.
- Statement 3 is correct: Biostimulants improve tolerance to abiotic stress, such as drought, salinity, and heat, by boosting plant metabolism and resilience.

### Qn 2:

#### **Explanation:**

- **Statement 1 Incorrect:** Copyright arises **automatically** when an original work is created and fixed in a tangible medium. **Registration is not mandatory** for protection under the Copyright Act, 1957.
- Statement 2 Correct: As per the Indian Copyright Act, for original literary, dramatic, musical, and artistic works, copyright lasts for the lifetime of the author plus 60 years after their death.
- Statement 3 Incorrect: Copyright protects expression of ideas, not the ideas themselves. This is a settled principle in copyright law known as the idea-expression dichotomy.

### Qn 3:

#### **Explanation:**

- **Statement 1 Incorrect**: Urban areas are **hotter**, not cooler, than rural areas due to less vegetation and more heat-absorbing surfaces.
- Statement 2 Correct: UHI is often more pronounced at night because urban surfaces slowly release the heat absorbed during the day, but this **depends** on local climate and land use. In dry areas, it can be higher during daytime.
- Statement 3 Correct: Asphalt and concrete absorb and store heat, contributing to higher urban temperatures.

#### **Explanation:**

• Statement 1: Correct.

According to the World Bank report (2025), Indian cities are projected to generate nearly 70% of the country's new employment by 2030, highlighting their critical role in economic growth.

• Statement 2: Incorrect.

The projected cost for building climate-resilient infrastructure in Indian cities is not \$5 billion, but \$2.4 trillion by 2050.
